## **Kopy Goldfields arranges a visit to the Krasny project in Bodaibo, Russia**

**Kopy Goldfields is pleased to invite shareholders and investors to participate in a trip to its Krasny project in the Irkutsk region of Russia. As soon as the current exploration program is finalized, the Krasny project will approach the production phase and the idea of the trip is to provide a close look at the Krasny project and review its future development scenario. The trip will also include a visit at the active production site of GV Gold.**

The trip will take place during Sunday, September 20 until Friday, September 25, 2015.

The preliminary itinerary of the trip includes:

Sunday 20/9	11.50 am	Air flight: depart Stockholm, arrive Moscow 2.50 pm
	5.25 pm	Air flight: depart Moscow to Irkutsk
Monday 21/9	4 am	Arrive Irkutsk
	10 am	Air flight: depart Irkutsk to Bodaibo
	12 noon - onwards	Check in at hotel in Bodaibo, lunch, visit Kopy Goldfields office including a project overview, Bodaibo sightseeing, early dinner.
Tuesday 22/9	7 am - onwards	Breakfast and travel (appr 350 km return by car) to the Krasny project and the GV Gold operation site. Late return to Bodaibo.
Wednesday 23/9	9 am	Visit Kopy Goldfields office, Bodaibo historical museum.
	1 pm	Air flight: depart Bodaibo to Irkutsk
	4 pm – onwards	Arrive Irkutsk and further travel to Baikal lake (60 km by car), check in at hotel on Baikal.
Thursday 24/9	9 am	Return to Irkutsk from Baikal
	12 am	Air flight: depart Irkutsk, arrive Moscow 1.30 pm

After returning to Moscow, the trip is officially over. Participants are free to return to Stockholm the same day (on Thursday) or to remain in Moscow for sightseeing. We recommend staying in Moscow and having at least Thursday as a buffer for various travel emergencies such as air flight delays.

Kopy Goldfields will arrange all the travel activities including visa invitations. Participants will carry all costs themselves and the total estimated cost for the trip is SEK 21,000 per person (including one night in Moscow), but the cost might vary dependent on the price of the air tickets, the Rub/SEK exchange rate and any unforeseen events. All flights will be booked in economy class. All participants are responsible for ensuring that they have adequate insurances. The conditions at the Bodaibo airport may result in weather related delays at last minute notice, which can severely impact the travel schedule and lead to delays and additional costs.
