- · Net sales amounted to SEK 353.0 (350.7) million, which corresponds to a growth of 0.7 (30.1) %.
- Operating result before amortizations and depreciations (EBITDA) decreased by 2.8 % and amounted to SEK 71.3 (73.4) million, corresponding to a margin of 20.2 (20.9) %. The previous year includes items affecting comparability of SEK 8.7 million.
- Operating result (EBIT) decreased by 4.2 % and amounted to SEK 60.7 (63.4) million, corresponding to a margin of 17.2 (18.1) %. The previous year includes items affecting comparability of SEK 8.7 million.
- Earnings per share amounted to SEK 4.03 (3.75).
- · Cash flow from operating activitites amounted to SEK 35.2 (20.6) million.

1 January - 30 June 2023

- · Net sales amounted to SEK 711.8 (672.8) million, which corresponds to a growth of 5.8 (33.8) %.
- Operating result before amortizations and depreciations (EBITDA) increased by 2.9 % and amounted to SEK 139.5 (135.5) million, corresponding to a margin of 19.6 (20.1) %. The previous year includes items affecting comparability of SEK 11.2 million.
- Operating result (EBIT) increased by 2.8 % and amounted to SEK 118.6 (115.3) million, corresponding to a margin of 16.7 (17.1) %. The previous year includes items affecting comparability of SEK 11.2 million.
- Earnings per share amounted to SEK 7.46 (7.17).
- · Cash flow from operating activitites amounted to SEK 68.0 (62.9) million.

CEO comments

Continued solid underlying profitability

For the second quarter of the year, Absolent Air Care Group reports net sales of SEK 353.0 (350.7) million. The profitability for the quarter is an operating margin before amortizations and depreciations of 20.2 (20.9) %, where the previous year includes items affecting comparability of approximately SEK 8.7 million related to a real estate sale and currency effects. Without these items, the profitability is higher than the previous year.

Industrial

For the period April-June, the Industrial business area reports slightly lower sales of SEK 279.8 (285.7) million, a decrease of about 2.1% compared to the previous year. However, order intake has increased by 10.9% compared to the previous year. Sales and profitability in the Americas region are affected by an ongoing relocation and consolidation of two of our production facilities. The other regions EMEA and APAC show growth for the quarter. The operating result before amortizations and depreciations (EBITDA) for the business area amounts to SEK 53.3 (66.3) million, where the comparison figures were positively affected by a real estate sale of SEK 3.5 million and currency effects of SEK 7.6 million. Adjusted for these effects, the Industrial business area delivers a profitability in line with the previous year.

Absolent Air Care Group is in an intensive phase where we make large changes and investments for the future in the Industrial business area. We have three major projects ongoing to ensure

that we, over time, have the most competitive offer on the market and ability to deliver that offer to customers more efficiently than others. The most substantial project is the development of new product architectures. The project will remain in the development phase for at least two more years, with the purpose of creating a comprehensive offer. The project will not only give us a better offer we can deliver efficiently, but also considerably simplify integration and marginal improvement of acquisitions. During the second quarter, we launched the first products within this project and they were very well received by the market, which is an acknowledgement that we are on the right track.

The two other projects are of consolidatory nature, where we create larger, more modern and more efficient production facilities in the UK and Canada. Except the obvious consolidation synergies, these projects are an opportunity to streamline processes, modernize systems and attract competence, which, in turn, gives us conditions to grow at a more rapid pace. Simultaneously, we continue our project to develop a product for carbon capture. It is a challenging project, in which we are progressing. The current prototype has the ability to capture carbon and transform to liquid form, and our focus is to make the process efficient enough to commercialize.

Commercial Kitchen

I am pleased to see that our other business area Commercial Kitchen continues to show strong sales of SEK 73.2 (65.0) million, corresponding to a growth of 12.6 % compared to the same quarter last year. The effect of good volumes together with marginal improvement is also an improved operating result before amortizations and depreciations (EBITDA) from SEK 10.0 million to SEK 15.0 million, corresponding to a margin of 20.5 (15.3) %. Within the business area, work continues with realizing synergies from the acquisition of the Dutch company Nu–Air that was completed at the end of the previous year.

The future

Long-term, we have a very positive view of the market as well as our ability to develop and deliver profitable growth. We are closely monitoring the development of our major customer segments and their propensity to invest, also in the current, more challenging, interest and economic situation. Our assessment is that the market is still favorable, albeit somewhat more cautious than before, and we see opportunities to make good business also in the short term. Altogether, I am very happy with the work we do to build a Group to lead our attractive industry for a long time, and we have confidence in the future.

The Group April - June 2023

Net sales

Net sales for the Group amounted to SEK 353.0 (350.7) million, which corresponds to a growth of 0.7 (30.1) %. The Commercial Kitchen business area showed a growth of 12.6 %, with a net sales increase from SEK 65.0 million to SEK 73.2 million. For Industrial, the Group's largest business area, net sales amounted to SEK 279.8 (285.7) million, where the EMEA and APAC regions showed growth while the Americas region recorded lower net sales.

Result

Operating result before amortizations and depreciations (EBITDA) amounted to SEK 71.3 (73.4) million, which corresponds to a margin of 20.2 (20.9) %. Operating result (EBIT) amounted to SEK 60.7 (63.4) million with an operating margin of 17.2 (18.1) %. Translation effects of foreign Group companies' results have impacted the operating result (EBIT) for the period with SEK 2.5 (1.9) million. The lower result comes from the Industrial business area, for which the operating result amounted to SEK 46.2 (58.8) million. For comparability, it is important to note that the previous year includes a positive effect from a real estate sale of SEK 3.5 million and positive currency effects of SEK 7.6 million. Without these non-recurring items, the operating result for the business area is basically on par with the previous year. Commercial Kitchen, the Group's other business area, recorded yet another strong guarter with a result of SEK 11.9 (7.9) million, where the increase is attributable to both volume and improved margin. Other operating income and expenses are SEK 9.2 million lower than the previous year, where SEK 3.5 million are related to a real estate sale during the second guarter of 2022 and the majority of the remaining part comes from currency effects. Without these effects, the Group records a higher operating result and operating margin than the previous year.

Net financial items amounted to SEK -1.3 (-7.4) million, where the previous year was burdened by a SEK 5.4 million write-down of a financial receivable. The current period is positively impacted by currency effects on financial items and negatively impacted by increased interest expenses due to higher interest levels. Result after tax amounted to SEK 45.7 (42.5) million.

Investments

During the period April-June, the Group has invested a total of SEK 4.5 (11.1) million in intangible and tangible fixed assets, where this period's investments mainly refer to capitalized product development costs and machinery. Cash flow from investing activities for the period also includes acquisition of the Swiss company AIRfina of SEK 12.8 million and earnout payments related to the acquisition of Quatro Air Technologies and Aerofil of SEK 34.8 million.

Cash flow

Cash flow from operating activitites before changes in working capital amounted to SEK 56.4 (60.0) million and the cash flow after changes in working capital amounted to SEK 35.2 (20.6) million. The higher cash flow is mainly an effect of more efficient working capital management.

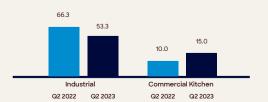
Financial position

Interest-bearing liabilities at the end of the period amounted to SEK 575.7 (650.5) million, of which SEK 66.4 (73.6) million refers to lease liabilities. The net debt for the Group amounted to SEK 346.1 (395.5) million, where the decrease is attributable to repayments. The equity ratio improved by 8.0 percentage points and amounted to 47.1 (39.1) % at the end of the period. The Parent company's credit facility totals SEK 800 million and expires in 2026.

The Group January - June 2023

Net sales

Net sales for the Group amounted to SEK 711.8 (672.8) million, which corresponds to a growth of 5.8 (33.8) %. Both business areas showed growth, with a net sales increase from SEK 543.3 million to SEK 562.7 million for Industrial and from SEK 129.5 million to SEK 149.1 million for Commercial Kitchen. Net sales increased in the EMEA and APAC regions, while Americas showed a decrease.

Result

Operating result before amortizations and depreciations (EBITDA) amounted to SEK 139.5 (135.5) million, which corresponds to a margin of 19.6 (20.1) %. Operating result (EBIT) amounted to SEK 118.6 (115.3) million with an operating margin of 16.7 (17.1) %. Translation effects of foreign Group companies' results have impacted the operating result (EBIT) for the period with SEK 3.9 (5.1) million. The result improvement is driven by the Commercial Kitchen business area, for which operating result (EBIT) increased from SEK 18.3 million to SEK 25.2 million. The increase is an effect of both increased volume and improved margin. The Industrial business area reports an operating result of SEK 98.3 (103.4) million, where it is important to note that the comparison figures include a positive effect of SEK 3.5 million from a real estate sale as well as positive currency effects of SEK 10.5 million. Without these effects, the business area records an improved operating result compared to the previous year.

Other operating income and expenses have decreased by SEK 11.4 million compared to the previous year, of which SEK 3.5 million is related to a real estate sale during the second quarter of 2022 and the majority of the remaining part is attributable to currency effects. Without these effects, the Group reports a higher operating margin than the first six months of 2022.

Net financial items amounted to SEK -8.5 (-10.8) million, where the previous year was burdened by a SEK 5.4 million write-down of a

financial receivable. Adjusted for this non-recurring item, net financial items have deteriorated, mainly attributable to higher interest expenses due to higher interest levels. Result after tax amounted to SEK 84.5 (81.1) million.

Investments

During the first half year, the Group has invested a total of SEK 8.2 (15.8) million in intangible and tangible fixed assets, where this year's investments mainly refer to capitalized product development costs and machinery. Cash flow from investing activities also includes acquisition of the Swiss company AIRfina of SEK 12.8 million and earnout payments related to the acquisitions of Quatro Air Technologies and Aerofil as well as Tessu Systems of SEK 60.2 million in total.

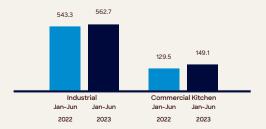
Cash flow

Cash flow from operating activitites before changes in working capital amounted to SEK 96.4 (119.1) million and the cash flow after changes in working capital amounted to SEK 68.0 (62.9) million. The improvement is to a large extent attributable to more efficient working capital management, while increased tax and interest payments had negative impact.

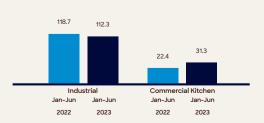
Financial position

Interest-bearing liabilities at the end of the period amounted to SEK 575.7 (650.5) million, of which SEK 66.4 (73.6) million refers to lease liabilities. The net debt for the Group amounted to SEK 346.1 (395.5) million, where the decrease is attributable to repayments made during the year. The equity ratio improved by 8.0 percentage points and amounted to 47.1 (39.1) % at the end of period. During the first half of the year, the Parent company has renewed and increased the credit facility with the bank Nordea. The credit facility has been increased to SEK 800 million and expires in 2026.

The financial risks are also further described in Note 22 in the Annual report for 2022. The reported risks, as they are described in the Annual report, are deemed to be essentially unchanged.

The current geopolitical situation is still a factor of uncertainty, as well as volatile macro factors such as inflation, interest rates and energy prices, and it cannot be ruled out that the Group, partners, suppliers and/or customers may be affected in the future, both directly and indirectly as a result of the above-mentioned uncertainties.

Accounting policies

This report has been prepared in accordance with IAS 34 Interim Financial Reporting and the Swedish Annual Accounts Act. The interim report for the Parent company has been prepared in accordance with the Swedish Annual Accounts Act and the Swedish Financial Reporting Board's recommendation RFR 2 Accounting for Legal Entities.

The applied accounting policies for the Group and the Parent company are consistent with the accounting policies used in the presentation of the Annual Report 2022.

No standards, amendments or interpretations effective from 2023 have had any material impact on Absolent Air Care Group's financial statements.

Note 1 Revenue

The Group's contracts with customers refer to sales of products for cleaning of process air in a variety of industries, in the Group's two business areas Industrial and Commercial Kitchen. Net sales refers only to revenue from contracts with customers. Related to the products, the Group also sell installation services in a many cases as well as maintenance. The Group sometimes also recharge freight to customers, depending on the incoterms.

In the majority of the Group's contracts with customers, products and installation are deemed to be distinct and are accounted for as separate performance obligations. However, for some contracts with customers the installation services do not meet the criteria for being distinct, since these contracts include a slightly higher degree of customization and the contract is more of a package solution where the installation cannot be separated. In these cases, products and installation are considered as one joint performance obligation. The Group's products come with standardized

warranties, which are assessed to be a part of the product and not considered as separate performance obligations.

The performance obligation for sale of products is deemed to be fulfilled when control is transferred to the customer, which is assessed to coincide with physical delivery to the customer. Installation services as well as service and maintenance are assessed to be performance obligations fulfilled over time. Hence, the revenue for these services is recognized as they are performed. However, installation is usually performed in connection with delivery of the products and mainly refers to short installation assignments. For these short installation assignments, the revenue is thus recognized in practice when the installation has been completed. For the customer contracts where products and installation are considered a joint performance obligation, the revenue is recognized over time, based on costs incurred in relation to total costs for the products and services under the contract.

Note 6 Business combinations

Nu-Air B.V.

As of December 1 2022, the Group acquired 100 percent of the Dutch company Nu-Air B.V. for a purchase price of EUR 2.3 million on a cash and debt-free basis. The acquisition is financed by available funds and the purchase price is paid over three years. The company has an annual turnover of approximately EUR 6 million, and forms together with Tessu Systems B.V., acquired by Absolent Air Care Group in 2021, a dominating player on the Dutch commercial kitchen ventilation market. Nu-Air is included in the Group's Commercial Kitchen business area.

The acquisition did not have any material impact on earnings per share for 2022. Transaction costs related to this acquisition amounted to SEK 1.0 million, and are recorded as administrative expenses in the Group income statement. The table summarizes purchase price as well as acquired assets and liabilities, recognized at fair value as of the acquisition date. The purchase price allocation is preliminary, and may be subject to adjustments.
